

Greetings, Directors!

We hope that marching band season wrapped up with great success, and that jazz and concert band season is off to a smooth start! This mailing serves to remind you of a few details concerning the 2019 Tallcorn Jazz Festival that we do not want you to miss. Firstly, just a reminder that the festival has changed from being Friday-Saturday to **Thursday-Friday**, the dates being **February 14th and 15th, 2019**. To be clear, this is only a change for the **2A** and **3A** bands, which will perform on **Thursday, February 14th**. **1A & 4A** bands will remain on **Friday** as in years past. Secondly, the deadline to register your bands either for competition or for comments only **December 1st, 2018**. If your band is not already registered, simply click this [link](#) and you will be taken to the 2019 registration form. Thirdly, the deadline to submit payment for participating bands is **December 15th, 2018**. As stated in our first mailing, all payments received after this date will incur a fifty-dollar administrative surcharge, as well as last choice of time slot, and an omission of the school's name from the t-shirts. As most of you know, this year we have been required by one of our t-shirt sponsors to gather data on potential UNI students and are now requiring all participating students fill out this [link](#) in order to help with the cost of tshirts. **Students will only receive their free tshirt after completing this short form**.
